**A BILL**

To provide for the authority for the successors and assigns of the Starr-Camargo Bridge Company to maintain and operate a toll bridge across the Rio Grande near Rio Grande City, Texas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STARR-CAMARGO BRIDGE.**

4 Public Law 87–532 (76 Stat. 153) is amended—

1 (1) in the first section, in subsection (a)(2)—

2 (A) by inserting “, and its successors and  
3 assigns,” after “State of Texas”;

4 (B) by inserting “consisting of not more  
5 than 14 lanes” after “approaches thereto”; and

6 (C) by striking “and for a period of sixty-  
7 six years from the date of completion of such  
8 bridge,”;

9 (2) in section 2, by inserting “and its succes-  
10 sors and assigns,” after “companies”;

11 (3) by redesignating sections 3, 4, and 5 as sec-  
12 tions 4, 5, and 6, respectively;

13 (4) by inserting after section 2 the following:

14 **“SEC. 3. RIGHTS OF STARR-CAMARGO BRIDGE COMPANY**  
15 **AND SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS.**

16 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Starr-Camargo Bridge  
17 Company and its successors and assigns shall have the  
18 rights and privileges granted to the B and P Bridge Com-  
19 pany and its successors and assigns under section 2 of  
20 the Act of May 1, 1928 (45 Stat. 471, chapter 466).

21 “(b) REQUIREMENT.—In exercising the rights and  
22 privileges granted under subsection (a), the Starr-  
23 Camargo Bridge Company and its successors and assigns  
24 shall act in accordance with—

25 “(1) just compensation requirements;

1 “(2) public proceeding requirements; and

2 “(3) any other requirements applicable to the  
3 exercise of the rights referred to in subsection (a)  
4 under the laws of the State of Texas.”; and

5 (5) in section 4 (as redesignated by paragraph  
6 (3))—

7 (A) by inserting “and its successors and  
8 assigns,” after “such company”;

9 (B) by striking “or” after “public agen-  
10 cy,”;

11 (C) by inserting “or to a corporation,”  
12 after “international bridge authority or commis-  
13 sion,”; and

14 (D) by striking “authority, or commission”  
15 each place it appears and inserting “authority,  
16 commission, or corporation”.
