Mr. KIRK (for himself and Mr. COONS) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to place signage on Federal land along the trail known as the “American Discovery Trail”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Discovery
5 Trail Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

1 (1) SECRETARY CONCERNED.—The term “Sec-
2 retary concerned” means—

3 (A) the Secretary of the Interior, with re-
4 spect to Federal land under the jurisdiction of
5 the Secretary of the Interior; or

6 (B) the Secretary of Agriculture, with re-
7 spect to Federal land under the jurisdiction of
8 the Secretary of Agriculture.

9 (2) TRAIL.—The term “Trail” means the trail
10 known as the “American Discovery Trail”, which
11 consists of approximately 6,800 miles of trails ex-
12 tending from Cape Henlopen State Park in Dela-
13 ware to Point Reyes National Seashore in California,
14 as generally described in volume 2 of the National
15 Park Service feasibility study dated June 1995.

16 **SEC. 3. SIGNAGE ALONG THE AMERICAN DISCOVERY TRAIL.**

17 (a) SIGNAGE AUTHORIZED.—As soon as practicable
18 after the date on which signage acceptable to the Sec-
19 retary concerned is donated to the United States for place-
20 ment on Federal land at points along the Trail, the Sec-
21 retary concerned shall place the signage on the Federal
22 land.

1 (b) NO FEDERAL FUNDS.—No Federal funds may be
2 used to acquire signage authorized for placement under
3 subsection (a).
