Mr. KIRK (for himself, Mr. INHOFE, Mr. GARDNER, Mr. MORAN, Mr. LANKFORD, and Mr. HATCH) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To prohibit the transfer or release of individuals detained at United States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, to state sponsors of terrorism.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON TRANSFER OR RELEASE OF**
4 **INDIVIDUALS DETAINED AT UNITED STATES**
5 **NAVAL STATION, GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA,**
6 **TO CERTAIN COUNTRIES.**

7 (a) PROHIBITION.—No amounts authorized to be ap-
8 propriated or otherwise available for the Department of
9 Defense may be used to transfer, release, or assist in the

1 transfer or release to a country specified in subsection (b)
2 of Khalid Sheikh Mohammed or any other detainee who—

3 (1) is not a United States citizen or a member
4 of the Armed Forces of the United States; and

5 (2) is or was held on or after January 20,
6 2009, at United States Naval Station, Guantanamo
7 Bay, Cuba, by the Department of Defense.

8 (b) COUNTRIES.—A country specified in this sub-
9 section is as follows:

10 (1) Libya

11 (2) Somalia.

12 (3) Yemen.

13 (4) A country that is a state sponsor of ter-
14 rorism.

15 (c) STATE SPONSOR OF TERRORISM DEFINED.—In
16 this section, the term “state sponsor of terrorism” has the
17 meaning given that term in section 301(13) of the Com-
18 prehensive Iran Sanctions, Accountability, and Divestment
19 Act of 2010 (22 U.S.C. 8451(13)).
