Mr. BENNET (for himself and Mr. BURR) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to equalize the excise tax on liquified petroleum gas and liquified natural gas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EQUALIZATION OF EXCISE TAX ON LIQUEFIED**
4 **PETROLEUM GAS AND LIQUEFIED NATURAL**
5 **GAS.**

6 (a) LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
8 4041(a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is
9 amended by striking “and” at the end of clause (i),

1 by redesignating clause (ii) as clause (iii), and by in-
2 serting after clause (i) the following new clause:

3 “(ii) in the case of liquefied petroleum
4 gas, 18.3 cents per energy equivalent of a
5 gallon of gasoline, and”.

6 (2) ENERGY EQUIVALENT OF A GALLON OF
7 GASOLINE.—Paragraph (2) of section 4041(a) of
8 such Code is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(C) ENERGY EQUIVALENT OF A GALLON
11 OF GASOLINE.—For purposes of this para-
12 graph, the term energy equivalent of a gallon of
13 gasoline means, with respect to a liquefied pe-
14 troleum gas fuel, the amount of such fuel hav-
15 ing a Btu content of 115,400 (lower heating
16 value).”.

17 (b) LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS.—

18 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
19 4041(a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as
20 amended by subsection (a)(1), is amended by strik-
21 ing “and” at the end of clause (ii), by striking the
22 period at the end of clause (iii) and inserting “,
23 and” and by inserting after clause (iii) the following
24 new clause:

1 “(iv) in the case of liquefied natural
2 gas, 24.3 cents per energy equivalent of a
3 gallon of diesel.”.

4 (2) ENERGY EQUIVALENT OF A GALLON OF
5 DIESEL.—Paragraph (2) of section 4041(a) of such
6 Code, as amended by subsection (a)(2), is amended
7 by adding at the end the following:

8 “(D) ENERGY EQUIVALENT OF A GALLON
9 OF DIESEL.—For purposes of this paragraph,
10 the term energy equivalent of a gallon of diesel
11 means, with respect to a liquefied natural gas
12 fuel, the amount of such fuel having a Btu con-
13 tent of 128,700 (lower heating value).”.

14 (3) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section
15 4041(a)(2)(B)(iii) of the Internal Revenue Code of
16 1986, as redesignated by subsection (a)(1), is
17 amended—

18 (A) by striking “liquefied natural gas,,”

19 and

20 (B) by striking “peat), and” and inserting
21 “peat) and”.

22 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
23 this section shall apply to any sale or use of fuel after
24 March 31, 2015.
