## A BILL

To extend the right of appeal to the Merit Systems Protection Board to certain employees of the United States Postal Service.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Postal Employee Ap-  
5 peal Rights Amendments Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. RIGHT OF APPEAL TO MERIT SYSTEMS PROTEC-**  
7 **TION BOARD.**

8 Section 1005(a)(4)(A)(ii)(I) of title 39, United States  
9 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1                   “(I) is an officer or employee of the Postal  
2           Service who—

3                   “(aa) is not represented by a bar-  
4           gaining representative recognized under  
5           section 1203; and

6                   “(bb) is in a supervisory, professional,  
7           technical, clerical, administrative, or mana-  
8           gerial position covered by the Executive  
9           and Administrative Schedule; and”.
