H. R. 1719

AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire approximately 44 acres of land in Martinez, California, for inclusion in the John Muir National Historic Site, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “John Muir National
3 Historic Site Expansion Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

5 In this Act:

6 (1) HISTORIC SITE.—The term “Historic Site”
7 means the John Muir National Historic Site in Mar-
8 tinez, California, established by Public Law 88–547
9 (78 Stat. 753).

10 (2) MAP.—The term “map” means the map en-
11 titled “John Muir National Historic Site Proposed
12 Boundary Expansion”, numbered 426/127150, and
13 dated November 2014.

14 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
15 the Secretary of the Interior.

16 **SEC. 3. JOHN MUIR NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE LAND ACQUI-**
17 **SITION.**

18 (a) ACQUISITION.—The Secretary may acquire by do-
19 nation the approximately 44 acres of land and any inter-
20 ests in the land that is identified on the map.

21 (b) BOUNDARY.—On the acquisition of the land au-
22 thorized under subsection (a), the Secretary shall adjust
23 the boundaries of the Historic Site to include the acquired
24 land.

1 (c) ADMINISTRATION.—The land and any interests in
2 land acquired under subsection (a) shall be administered
3 as part of the National Historic Site.
