To reauthorize the West Valley demonstration project, and

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WEST VALLEY DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.**

4 (a) *REAUTHORIZATION.*—Section 3(a) of the *West Val-*
5 *ley Demonstration Project Act (Public Law 96–368; 42*
6 *U.S.C. 2021a note)* is amended by striking “\$5,000,000 for
7 *the fiscal year ending September 30, 1981”* and inserting
8 *“\$75,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2019 through 2028”.*

9 (b) *REPORT.*—Not later than 18 months after the date
10 *of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall sub-*
11 *mit to Congress a report that describes—*

12 (1) *the volumes, origins, and types of radioactive*
13 *waste at the Western New York Service Center in*
14 *West Valley, New York;*

15 (2) *what options have been identified for dis-*
16 *posal of each such type of radioactive waste;*

17 (3) *what is known about the costs of, and time-*
18 *frames for, each such option;*

19 (4) *the benefits and challenges of each such op-*
20 *tion, according to the State of New York and the De-*
21 *partment of Energy; and*

22 (5) *as of the date of enactment of this Act—*

23 (A) *how much has been spent on the dis-*
24 *posal of radioactive waste associated with the*
25 *demonstration project prescribed by section 2(a)*

1 *of the West Valley Demonstration Project Act;*
2 *and*

3 *(B) what volumes and types of radioactive*
4 *waste have been disposed of from the Western*
5 *New York Service Center.*
