Ms. MENG (for herself and Mrs. CAROLYN B. MALONEY of New York) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To require menstrual product ingredient list labels.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Menstrual Products
5 Right to Know Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. LABELING REQUIREMENT FOR MENSTRUAL PROD-**
7 **UCTS.**

8 (a) Menstrual products, such as menstrual cups;
9 scented, scented deodorized, or unscented menstrual pads
10 or tampons; therapeutic vaginal douche apparatuses; or
11 obstetrical and gynecological devices described in section

1 884.5400, 884.5425, 884.5435, 884.5460, 884.5470, or
2 884.5900 of title 21, Code of Federal Regulations (or any
3 successor regulation), shall be deemed to be misbranded
4 under section 502 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cos-
5 metic Act (21 U.S.C. 352) unless it bears a label listing
6 the name of each ingredient or component of the device
7 in order of the most predominant ingredient or component
8 to the least predominant ingredient or component.

9 (b) The amendment made by subsection (a) applies
10 only with respect to a device manufactured more than one
11 year after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
