AN ACT

To redesignate the Martin Luther King, Junior, National Historic Site in the State of Georgia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Martin Luther King,
3 Jr. National Historical Park Act of 2017”.

4 **SEC. 2. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. NATIONAL HISTORICAL**
5 **PARK.**

6 The Act entitled “An Act to establish the Martin Lu-
7 ther King, Junior, National Historic Site in the State of
8 Georgia, and for other purposes” (Public Law 96–428)
9 is amended—

10 (1) in subsection (a) of the first section, by
11 striking “the map entitled ‘Martin Luther King,
12 Junior, National Historic Site Boundary Map’, num-
13 ber 489/80,013B, and dated September 1992” and
14 inserting “the map entitled ‘Martin Luther King, Jr.
15 National Historical Park Proposed Boundary Revi-
16 sion’, numbered 489/128,786 and dated June
17 2015”;

18 (2) by striking “Martin Luther King, Junior,
19 National Historic Site” each place it appears and in-
20 sserting “Martin Luther King, Jr. National Histor-
21 ical Park”;

22 (3) by striking “national historic site” each
23 place it appears and inserting “national historical
24 park”; and

25 (4) by striking “historic site” each place it ap-
26 pears and inserting “historical park”.

1 **SEC. 3. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law (other than this Act), map,
3 regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
4 States to “Martin Luther King, Junior, National Historic
5 Site” shall be deemed to be a reference to “Martin Luther
6 King, Jr. National Historical Park”.
