3 resolution (H. Con. Res. 119) expressing the sense of Con-
4 gress that a carbon tax would be detrimental to the United
5 States economy. All points of order against consideration
6 of the concurrent resolution are waived. The concurrent

1 resolution shall be considered as read. All points of order
2 against provisions in the concurrent resolution are waived.
3 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
4 the concurrent resolution and preamble to adoption with-
5 out intervening motion or demand for division of the ques-
6 tion except one hour of debate equally divided and con-
7 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
8 Committee on Ways and Means.
