Mr. BUCK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 725) to amend title 28, United States Code, to prevent fraudulent joinder.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 725) to amend title 28, United
6 States Code, to prevent fraudulent joinder. The first read-
7 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
8 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-

1 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
2 hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-
3 ing minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary.
4 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
5 amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be
6 considered as read. All points of order against provisions
7 in the bill are waived. No amendment to the bill shall be
8 in order except those printed in the report of the Com-
9 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such
10 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in
11 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated
12 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
13 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
14 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall
15 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to
16 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
17 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
18 such amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consid-
19 eration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
20 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
21 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall
22 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
23 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
24 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
