RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1430) to prohibit the Environmental Protection Agency from proposing, finalizing, or disseminating regulations or assessments based upon science that is not transparent or reproducible.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 1430) to prohibit the Environmental Protection Agency
4 from proposing, finalizing, or disseminating regulations or
5 assessments based upon science that is not transparent

1 or reproducible. All points of order against consideration
2 of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read.
3 All points of order against provisions in the bill are
4 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-
5 dered on the bill and on any amendment thereto to final
6 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
7 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and
8 ranking minority member of the Committee on Science,
9 Space, and Technology; and (2) one motion to recommit.
