RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2213) to amend the Anti-Border Corruption Act of 2010 to authorize certain polygraph waiver authority, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 2213) to amend the Anti-Border Corruption Act of 2010
4 to authorize certain polygraph waiver authority, and for
5 other purposes. All points of order against consideration
6 of the bill are waived. The amendment in the nature of

1 a substitute recommended by the Committee on Homeland
2 Security now printed in the bill shall be considered as
3 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read.
4 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-
5 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered
6 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further
7 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening
8 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
9 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
10 the Committee on Homeland Security; (2) the further
11 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on
12 Rules accompanying this resolution, if offered by the
13 Member designated in the report, which shall be in order
14 without intervention of any point of order, shall be consid-
15 ered as read, shall be separately debatable for the time
16 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by
17 the proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject
18 to a demand for division of the question; and (3) one mo-
19 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
