2 immigration laws, and for other purposes. All points of
3 order against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill
4 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
5 provisions in the bill are waived. The previous question
6 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on any
7 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
8 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
9 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
10 the Committee on the Judiciary; and (2) one motion to
11 recommit.
