1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 36) to amend title 18, United States Code, to protect pain-
4 capable unborn children, and for other purposes. All
5 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
6 The bill shall be considered as read. All points of order
7 against provisions in the bill are waived. The previous

1 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on
2 any amendment thereto to final passage without inter-
3 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
4 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
5 member of the Committee on the Judiciary; and (2) one
6 motion to recommit.
