## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3922) to extend funding for certain public health programs, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 3922) to extend funding for certain public health pro-  
4 grams, and for other purposes. All points of order against  
5 consideration of the bill are waived. In lieu of the amend-  
6 ment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the  
7 Committee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the

1 bill, the amendment printed in part A of the report of the  
2 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, modi-  
3 fied by the amendment printed in part B of that report,  
4 shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall  
5 be considered as read. All points of order against provi-  
6 sions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous  
7 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as  
8 amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to final  
9 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour  
10 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and  
11 ranking minority member of the Committee on Energy  
12 and Commerce; and (2) one motion to recommit with or  
13 without instructions.
