RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 38) to amend title 18, United States Code, to provide a means by which nonresidents of a State whose residents may carry concealed firearms may also do so in the State.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 38) to amend title 18, United States Code, to provide a
4 means by which nonresidents of a State whose residents
5 may carry concealed firearms may also do so in the State.

1 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
2 waived. In lieu of the amendment in the nature of a sub-
3 stitute recommended by the Committee on the Judiciary
4 now printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature of
5 a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee
6 Print 115-45 shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as
7 amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order
8 against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The
9 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
10 bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto,
11 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
12 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
13 and ranking minority member of the Committee on the
14 Judiciary; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without
15 instructions.
