## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 36) providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the final rule of the Bureau of Land Management relating to “Waste Prevention, Production Subject to Royalties, and Resource Conservation”, and providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. 1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the joint resolu-  
3 tion (H.J. Res. 36) providing for congressional dis-  
4 approval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code,  
5 of the final rule of the Bureau of Land Management relat-  
6 ing to “Waste Prevention, Production Subject to Royal-  
7 ties, and Resource Conservation”. All points of order  
8 against consideration of the joint resolution are waived.  
9 The joint resolution shall be considered as read. All points  
10 of order against provisions in the joint resolution are  
11 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
12 dered on the joint resolution and on any amendment  
13 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:  
14 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by  
15 the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee  
16 on Natural Resources; and (2) one motion to recommit.

17       SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
18 in order to consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J.  
19 Res. 37) disapproving the rule submitted by the Depart-  
20 ment of Defense, the General Services Administration,  
21 and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration  
22 relating to the Federal Acquisition Regulation. All points  
23 of order against consideration of the joint resolution are

1 waived. The joint resolution shall be considered as read.  
2 All points of order against provisions in the joint resolu-  
3 tion are waived. The previous question shall be considered  
4 as ordered on the joint resolution and on any amendment  
5 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:  
6 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by  
7 the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee  
8 on Oversight and Government Reform; and (2) one motion  
9 to recommit.
