Mr. COLE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6147) making appropriations for the Department of the Interior, environment, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 6147) making appropriations for
6 the Department of the Interior, environment, and related

1 agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019,
2 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall
3 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-
4 ation of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
5 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
6 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
7 member of the Committee on Appropriations. After gen-
8 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
9 under the five-minute rule. An amendment in the nature
10 of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee
11 Print 115-81 shall be considered as adopted in the House
12 and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as amended,
13 shall be considered as the original bill for the purpose of
14 further amendment under the five-minute rule and shall
15 be considered as read. Points of order against provisions
16 in the bill, as amended, for failure to comply with clause
17 2 or clause 5(a) of rule XXI are waived except as follows:
18 beginning with the colon on page 251, line 5, through
19 "2012" on page 251, line 8. Where points of order are
20 waived against part of a paragraph, points of order
21 against a provision in another part of such paragraph may
22 be made only against such provision and not against the
23 entire paragraph. No further amendment to the bill, as
24 amended, shall be in order except those printed in the re-
25 port of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolu-

1 tion and pro forma amendments described in section 2 of
2 this resolution. Each further amendment printed in the
3 report of the Committee on Rules shall be considered only
4 in the order printed in the report, may be offered only
5 by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered
6 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the
7 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
8 an opponent, may be withdrawn by the proponent at any
9 time before action thereon, shall not be subject to amend-
10 ment except as provided by section 2 of this resolution,
11 and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the
12 question in the House or in the Committee of the Whole.
13 All points of order against such further amendments are
14 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
15 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill,
16 as amended, to the House with such further amendments
17 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall
18 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
19 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
20 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.

21 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 6147 for
22 amendment, the chair and ranking minority member of
23 the Committee on Appropriations or their respective des-
24 ignees may offer up to 10 pro forma amendments each
25 at any point for the purpose of debate.
