A BILL

To amend the Denali National Park Improvement Act to clarify certain provisions relating to the natural gas pipeline authorized in the Denali National Park and Preserve.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DENALI NATIONAL PARK AND PRESERVE NAT-**
4 **URAL GAS PIPELINE.**

5 (a) PERMIT.—Section 3(b)(1) of the Denali National
6 Park Improvement Act (Public Law 113–33; 127 Stat.
7 516) is amended by striking “within, along, or near the

1 approximately 7-mile segment of the George Parks High-
 2 way that runs through the Park”.

3 (b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—Section 3(c)(1) of the
 4 Denali National Park Improvement Act (Public Law 113–
 5 33; 127 Stat. 516) is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “and”
 7 after the semicolon;

8 (2) by striking subparagraph (B); and

9 (3) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as sub-
 10 paragraph (B).

11 (c) APPLICABLE LAW.—Section 3 of the Denali Na-
 12 tional Park Improvement Act (Public Law 113–33; 127
 13 Stat. 515) is amended by adding at the end the following:

14 “(d) APPLICABLE LAW.—A high pressure gas trans-
 15 mission pipeline (including appurtenances) in a nonwilder-
 16 ness area within the boundary of the Park, shall not be
 17 subject to title XI of the Alaska National Interest Lands
 18 Conservation Act (16 U.S.C. 3161 et seq.).”.

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
