A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit awarding credit toward service of sentences for satisfactory behavior for certain drug offenses.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Early Release for
5 Fentanyl Traffickers Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CREDIT TOWARD SERVICE OF SENTENCE FOR SAT-**
7 **ISFACTORY BEHAVIOR.**

8 Section 3624(b) of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(5) No credit may be awarded under this sub-
2 section to any prisoner who is serving a term of im-
3 prisonment for a violation of section
4 401(b)(1)(A)(vi) of the Controlled Substances Act
5 (21 U.S.C. 841).”.
