A BILL

To amend the Consumer Financial Protection Act of 2010 to subject the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection to the regular appropriations process, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Consumer Financial
5 Protection Bureau Accountability Act of 2017”.

1 (A) by striking paragraphs (1) through (3)
2 and inserting the following:

3 “(1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

4 There is authorized to be appropriated such funds as
5 may be necessary to carry out this title for fiscal
6 year 2019.”; and

7 (B) by redesignating paragraph (4) as
8 paragraph (2).

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
10 this Act shall take effect on October 1, 2018.
