Authorizing the use of Emancipation Hall in the Capitol Visitor Center for a ceremony to present the Congressional Gold Medal collectively to the Chinese-American veterans of World War II.

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF EMANCIPATION HALL FOR CEREMONY**
4 **TO PRESENT CONGRESSIONAL GOLD MEDAL**
5 **TO CHINESE-AMERICAN VETERANS OF**
6 **WORLD WAR II.**

7 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Emancipation Hall in the
8 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on April

1 29, 2020, for a ceremony to present the Congressional
2 Gold Medal collectively to the Chinese-American veterans
3 of World War II, in recognition of their dedicated service
4 during World War II.

5 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the
6 conduct of the ceremony described in subsection (a) shall
7 be carried out in accordance with such conditions as the
8 Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.
