A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds during a lapse in appropriations to support congressional delegations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No CODELs During
5 Shutdowns Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.**

7 (a) PROHIBITION.—An executive agency may not ex-
8 pend any funds for the purpose of supporting official trav-
9 el undertaken by more than one Member of Congress dur-

1 ing any period in which there is a lapse in appropriations
2 for any instrumentality of the Federal Government.

3 (b) EXCEPTION.—An executive agency may expend
4 funds for the purpose described under subsection (a) if
5 the President, in consultation with the Speaker of the
6 House of Representatives and the Majority leader of the
7 Senate, waives the prohibition under such subsection for
8 such purpose.

9 (c) EXECUTIVE AGENCY DEFINED.—The term “exec-
10 utive agency” has the meaning given that term in section
11 133 of title 41, United States Code.

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
