3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting and Secur-
5 ing Florida’s Coastline Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT EXTENSION OF MORATORIUM ON**
7 **LEASING IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE GULF**
8 **OF MEXICO.**

9 Section 104(a) of the Gulf of Mexico Energy Security
10 Act of 2006 (43 U.S.C. 1331 note) is amended by striking
11 “Effective during” and all that follows through “the Sec-
