3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION IN CREDIT HOUR REQUIREMENT**
4 **FOR EDITH NOURSE ROGERS STEM SCHOL-**
5 **ARSHIP.**

6 Section 3320(b)(4)(A)(i) of title 38, United States
7 Code, is amended by striking “more than the standard
8 128 semester (or 192 quarter) credit hours” and inserting
9 “at least the standard 120 semester (or 180 quarter) cred-
10 it hours”.

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
