A BILL

To amend the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 to provide for certain changes to the semiannual report of the Attorney General to Congress regarding actions taken under that Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “FISA Reform Act of
5 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. CHANGES TO THE SEMIANNUAL REPORT OF THE**
2 **ATTORNEY GENERAL.**

3 Section 601(a) of the Foreign Intelligence Surveil-
4 lance Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1871(a)) is amended—

5 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
6 striking “the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
7 ligence of the House of Representatives, the Select
8 Committee on Intelligence of the Senate, and the
9 Committees on the Judiciary of the House of Rep-
10 resentatives and the Senate” and inserting the fol-
11 lowing: “the Speaker and minority leader of the
12 House of Representatives and the majority leader
13 and minority leader of the Senate”;

14 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking “and” at the
15 end;

16 (3) in paragraph (5), by striking the period at
17 the end and inserting “; and”; and

18 (4) by adding at the end the following:

19 “(6) the identity of any person targeted for an
20 order under this Act who is [associated with a can-
21 didate for President of a major party (as defined in
22 section 9002(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of
23 1986)].”.

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
