## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 840) to amend title 38, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to provide child care assistance to veterans receiving certain medical services provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs; providing for the adoption of the resolution (H. Res. 86) providing amounts for the expenses of the Select Committee on the Climate Crisis and the Select Committee on the Modernization of Congress; and providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule 3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-4 5 ation of the bill (H.R. 840) to amend title 38, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs 6 7 to provide child care assistance to veterans receiving cer-8 tain medical services provided by the Department of Vet-9 erans Affairs. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consideration of 10 11 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and 12 13 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of 14 the Committee on Veterans' Affairs. After general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-15 16 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute 17 18 rule an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 116-3. That amend-19 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as 20 21 read. All points of order against that amendment in the 22 nature of a substitute are waived. No amendment to that amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order 23 except those printed in the report of the Committee on 24 •HRES 105 RH

Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-1 2 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-3 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the 4 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for 5 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-6 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be 7 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-8 mand for division of the question in the House or in the 9 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such 10 amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consider-11 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise 12 and report the bill to the House with such amendments 13 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted 14 15 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-16 17 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-18 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without intervening motion except one motion to recommit 19 with or without instructions. 20

21 SEC. 2. House Resolution 86 is hereby adopted.

SEC. 3. It shall be in order at any time through the legislative day of February 15, 2019, for the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules as though under clause 1 of rule XV. The Speaker or her

- 2~ ignee on the designation of any matter for consideration
