2 shall be in order to consider in the House without inter-  
3 vention of any question of consideration the bill (H.R.  
4 8015) to maintain prompt and reliable postal services dur-  
5 ing the COVID–19 health emergency, and for other pur-  
6 poses. All points of order against consideration of the bill  
7 are waived. An amendment in the nature of a substitute

1 consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 116-61,  
2 modified by the amendment printed in the report of the  
3 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall  
4 be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be  
5 considered as read. All points of order against provisions  
6 in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question  
7 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,  
8 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage  
9 without intervening motion except: (1) two hours of debate  
10 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking  
11 minority member of the Committee on Oversight and Re-  
12 form; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without in-  
13 structions.
