Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2722) to protect elections for public office by providing financial support and enhanced security for the infrastructure used to carry out such elections, and for other purposes; waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3351) making appropriations for financial services and general government for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, and for other purposes.

Mr. MCGOVERN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2722) to protect elections for public office by providing financial support and enhanced security for the infrastructure used to carry out such elections, and for other purposes; waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3351) making appropriations for financial

services and general government for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 2722) to protect elections for public office by providing  
4 financial support and enhanced security for the infrastruc-  
5 ture used to carry out such elections, and for other pur-  
6 poses. All points of order against consideration of the bill  
7 are waived. In lieu of the amendment in the nature of a  
8 substitute recommended by the Committee on House Ad-  
9 ministration now printed in the bill, an amendment in the  
10 nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-  
11 mittee Print 116-20, modified by the amendment printed  
12 in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-  
13 panying this resolution, shall be considered as adopted.  
14 The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All  
15 points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended,  
16 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as  
17 ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further  
18 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening  
19 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and  
20 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of  
21 the Committee on House Administration; and (2) one mo-  
22 tion to recommit with or without instructions.

23       SEC. 2. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII  
24 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-

1 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the  
2 House is waived with respect to any resolution reported  
3 through the legislative day of June 27, 2019, relating to  
4 a measure making appropriations.

5       SEC. 3. At any time after adoption of this resolution  
6 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,  
7 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the  
8 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration  
9 of the bill (H.R. 3351) making appropriations for financial  
10 services and general government for the fiscal year ending  
11 September 30, 2020, and for other purposes. The first  
12 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of  
13 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General  
14 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
15 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and  
16 ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropria-  
17 tions. After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
18 amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be  
19 considered as read. Points of order against provisions in  
20 the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 or clause 5(a)  
21 of rule XXI are waived.

22       SEC. 4. (a) No amendment to the bill shall be in order  
23 except those printed in part B of the report of the Com-  
24 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution, amend-  
25 ments en bloc described in section 5 of this resolution, and

1 pro forma amendments described in section 6 of this reso-  
2 lution.

3 (b) Each amendment printed in part B of the report  
4 of the Committee on Rules shall be considered only in the  
5 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-  
6 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,  
7 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report  
8 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an  
9 opponent, may be withdrawn by the proponent at any time  
10 before action thereon, shall not be subject to amendment  
11 except as provided by section 6 of this resolution, and shall  
12 not be subject to a demand for division of the question  
13 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole.

14 (c) All points of order against amendments printed  
15 in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules or  
16 against amendments en bloc described in section 5 of this  
17 resolution are waived.

18 SEC. 5. It shall be in order at any time for the chair  
19 of the Committee on Appropriations or her designee to  
20 offer amendments en bloc consisting of amendments print-  
21 ed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules ac-  
22 companying this resolution not earlier disposed of. Amend-  
23 ments en bloc offered pursuant to this section shall be con-  
24 sidered as read, shall be debatable for 20 minutes equally  
25 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority

1 member of the Committee on Appropriations or their re-  
2 spective designees, shall not be subject to amendment ex-  
3 cept as provided by section 6 of this resolution, and shall  
4 not be subject to a demand for division of the question  
5 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole.

6       SEC. 6. During consideration of the bill for amend-  
7 ment, the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-  
8 mittee on Appropriations or their respective designees may  
9 offer up to 5 pro forma amendments each at any point  
10 for the purpose of debate.

11       SEC. 7. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill  
12 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the  
13 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been  
14 adopted. In the case of sundry amendments reported from  
15 the Committee, the question of their adoption shall be put  
16 to the House en gros and without division of the question.  
17 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
18 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without  
19 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with  
20 or without instructions.
