Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to seek to enter into an agreement with the city of Vallejo, California, for the transfer of Mare Island Naval Cemetery in Vallejo, California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF MARE ISLAND NAVAL CEMETERY**
4 **TO SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS FOR**
5 **MAINTENANCE BY NATIONAL CEMETERY AD-**
6 **MINISTRATION.**

7 (a) AGREEMENT.—Beginning on the date that is 180
8 days after the date on which the Secretary submits the

1 report required by subsection (c)(1), the Secretary of Vet-
2 erans Affairs shall seek to enter into an agreement with
3 the city of Vallejo, California, under which the city of
4 Vallejo shall transfer to the Secretary all right, title, and
5 interest in the Mare Island Naval Cemetery in Vallejo,
6 California, at no cost to the Secretary. The Secretary shall
7 seek to enter into such agreement before the date that
8 is one year after the date on which such report is sub-
9 mitted.

10 (b) MAINTENANCE BY NATIONAL CEMETERY ADMIN-
11 ISTRATION.—If the Mare Island Naval Cemetery is trans-
12 ferred to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs pursuant to
13 subsection (a), the National Cemetery Administration
14 shall maintain the cemetery as a national shrine.

15 (c) REPORT.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
17 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
18 retary shall submit to the Committee on Veterans'
19 Affairs of the Senate and the Committee on Vet-
20 erans' Affairs of the House of Representatives a re-
21 port on the feasibility and advisability of exercising
22 the authority granted by subsection (a).

23 (2) CONTENTS.—The report submitted under
24 paragraph (1) shall include the following:

1 (A) An assessment of the feasibility and
2 advisability of exercising the authority granted
3 by subsection (a).

4 (B) An estimate of the costs, including
5 both direct and indirect costs, that the Depart-
6 ment of Veterans Affairs would incur by exer-
7 cising such authority.

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
