3 **SECTION 1. BENJAMIN A. GILMAN POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 40 Fulton Street in Middletown,
6 New York, shall be known and designated as the “Ben-
7 jamin A. Gilman Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

- 1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Benjamin A. Gilman
- 3 Post Office Building”.
