## A BILL

To ensure adequate use and access to the existing Bolts Ditch headgate and ditch segment within the Holy Cross Wilderness in Eagle County, Colorado, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bolts Ditch Access  
5 and Use Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BOLTS DITCH ACCESS.**

7 (a) ACCESS GRANTED.—The Secretary of Agriculture  
8 shall permit by special use authorization nonmotorized ac-

1 cess and use, in accordance with section 293.6 of title 36,  
2 Code of Federal Regulations, of the Bolts Ditch Headgate  
3 and the Bolts Ditch within the Holy Cross Wilderness,  
4 Colorado, as designated by Public Law 96–560, for the  
5 purposes of the diversion of water and use, maintenance,  
6 and repair of such ditch and headgate by the Town of  
7 Minturn, Colorado, a Colorado Home Rule Municipality.

8 (b) LOCATION OF FACILITIES.—The Bolts Ditch  
9 headgate and ditch segment referenced in subsection (a)  
10 are as generally depicted on the map entitled “Bolts Ditch  
11 headgate and Ditch Segment” and dated November, 2015.
