A BILL

To observe the lives lost in the United States due to the
COVID–19 pandemic.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “COVID–19 Pandemic
5 Moment of Silence Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MOMENT OF SILENCE FOR THE VICTIMS OF THE**
7 **COVID–19 PANDEMIC.**

8 The President shall issue a proclamation calling on
9 the people of the United States to observe a moment of

1 silence at 12:00 p.m. (local time) on Monday, June 1,
2 2020, as a mark of respect to the memory of the more
3 than 100,000 lives lost in the United States due to the
4 COVID–19 pandemic, as well as their families.
