3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CHEMICAL FACILITY ANTI-TER-**
4 **RORISM STANDARDS PROGRAM OF THE DE-**
5 **PARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5 of the Protecting and
7 Securing Chemical Facilities from Terrorist Attacks Act
8 of 2014 (Public Law 113–254; 6 U.S.C. 621 note) is

1 amended by striking “July 23, 2020” and inserting “July
2 27, 2023”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date that is 1 day
5 after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
