CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress that the United States representative to the United Nations Commission on Narcotic Drugs should use the voice, vote, and influence of the United States to seek to de-schedule cannabis from Schedule I of the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs of 1961 and take other related actions.

3 President should direct the United States representative
4 to the United Nations Commission on Narcotic Drugs to
5 use the voice, vote, and influence of the United States at
6 the Commission to seek to de-schedule cannabis from

1 Schedule I of the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs
2 of 1961, expunge and forgive penalties relating to can-
3 nabis for prior offenders, and treat cannabis as a com-
4 modity similar to other agricultural commodities.
