## A BILL

To amend the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to update the Federal purchase requirement to ensure the use of 100 percent renewable energy by 2050, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Green Energy for Fed-  
5 eral Buildings Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FEDERAL PURCHASE REQUIREMENT.**

7 Section 203 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (42  
8 U.S.C. 15852) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a)—

2 (A) by amending paragraph (3) to read as  
3 follows:

4 “(3) Not less than 7.5 percent in fiscal years  
5 2013 through 2019.”; and

6 (B) by adding at the end the following:

7 “(4) Not less than 35 percent in fiscal years  
8 2030 through 2039.

9 “(5) Not less than 75 percent in fiscal years  
10 2040 through 2049.

11 “(6) Not less than 100 percent in fiscal year  
12 2050 and each fiscal year thereafter.”; and

13 (2) by amending subsection (c) to read as fol-  
14 lows:

15 “(c) FEASIBILITY.—In carrying out this section, the  
16 Secretary shall seek to ensure that, to the maximum ex-  
17 tent economically feasible and technically practicable, the  
18 Federal Government consumes renewable energy pro-  
19 duced—

20 “(1) on-site at a Federal facility;

21 “(2) on Federal lands; or

22 “(3) on Indian land as defined in section 2601  
23 of the Energy Policy Act of 1992 (25 U.S.C.  
24 3501).”.
