1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Highlands Conserva-						
3	tion Reauthorization Act of 2022".						
4	SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE HIGHLANDS CON-						
5	SERVATION ACT.						
6	The Highlands Conservation Act (Public Law 108-						
7	421; 118 Stat. 2375) is amended—						
8	(1) in section 3—						
9	(A) by amending paragraph (1) to read as						
10	follows:						
11	"(1) Highlands region.—The term 'High-						
12	lands region' means—						
13	"(A) the area depicted on the map entitled						
14	'The Highlands Region', dated June 2004, up-						
15	dated after the date of enactment of the High						
16	lands Conservation Reauthorization Act of 2022						
17	to comprise each municipality included on the						
18	list of municipalities included in the Highlands						
19	region as of that date of enactment, and main-						
20	tained in the headquarters of the Forest Service						
21	in Washington, District of Columbia; and						
22	"(B) a municipality approved by the Direc-						
23	tor of the United States Fish and Wildlife Serv-						
24	ice under section 4(e).";						
25	(B) in paragraph (3), by amending sub-						
26	paragraph (B) to read as follows:						

1	"(B) identified by a Highlands State as					
2	having high conservation value using the best					
3	available science and geographic information					
4	systems; and";					
5	(C) in paragraph (4)(A), by striking "; or"					
6	and inserting ", including a political subdivision					
7	thereof; or"; and					
8	(D) by striking paragraphs (5) through					
9	(7);					
10	(2) in section 4—					
11	(A) in subsection $(a)(1)$, by striking "in					
12	the Study' and all that follows through the end					
13	of the paragraph and inserting "using the best					
14	available science and geographic information					
15	systems; and";					
16	(B) in subsection (c), by amending para-					
17	graph (5) to read as follows:					
18	"(5) provides that land conservation partner-					
19	ship projects will be consistent with areas identified					
20	as having high conservation value in accordance with					
21	the purposes described in section 2 in the Highlands					
22	region.";					
23	(C) in subsection (e), by striking "fiscal					
24	years 2005 through 2021" and inserting "fiscal					
25	years 2023 through 2029";					

1	(D) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-				
2	section (g); and				
3	(E) by inserting after subsection (d) the				
4	following:				
5	"(e) Request for Inclusion of Additional Mu-				
6	NICIPALITY.—The Director of the United States Fish and				
7	Wildlife Service may, at the request of a Highlands State				
8	8 with the concurrence of the municipality, approve the in				
9	clusion of a municipality within the State as part of the				
10	Highlands region.				
11	"(f) Limitation on Administrative Expenses.—				
12	"(1) Federal administration.—The Sec-				
13	retary of the Interior may not expend more than				
14	\$300,000 for the administration of this Act in each				
15	fiscal year.				
16	"(2) State administration.—A State that				
17	receives funds under this section for a land con-				
18	servation partnership project may not use more than				
19	5 percent of the funds to administer the land con-				
20	servation partnership project.";				
21	(3) in section 5—				
22	(A) in subsection (a), by striking "the				
23	Study, Update, and any future study that the				
24	Forest Service may undertake in";				
25	(B) in subsection (b)—				

1	(i) in paragraph (1), by striking ", in-					
2	cluding a Pennsylvania and Connecticut					
3	Update"; and					
4	(ii) in paragraph (2), by striking "the					
5	findings" and all that follows through the					
6	end of the paragraph and inserting "with					
7	stakeholders regarding implementation of					
8	the program; and"; and					
9	(C) in subsection (c), by striking "2005					
10	through 2014" and inserting "2023 through					
11	2029''; and					
12	(4) in section 6, by adding at the end the fol-					
13	lowing:					
14	"(f) Appraisal Methodology.—					
15	"(1) In general.—With respect to an ap-					
16	praisal related to a land acquisition carried out					
17	under this Act, a Highlands State shall use an ap-					
18	praisal methodology approved by the Secretary of					
19	the Interior.					
20	"(2) ALTERNATIVE APPRAISAL METHOD-					
21	OLOGY.—A Highlands State may petition the Sec-					
22	retary of the Interior to consider an alternative ap-					
23	praisal methodology when there is a conflict, in any					
24	Highlands State, between—					

1	"(A) an appraisal methodology approved					
2	by the Secretary of the Interior under para-					
3	graph (1); and					
4	"(B) applicable State law.".
