A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to promulgate a national primary drinking water regulation for chromium-6, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHROMIUM-6 NATIONAL PRIMARY DRINKING**
4 **WATER REGULATION.**

5 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment
6 of this Act, the Administrator of the Environmental Pro-
7 tection Agency shall publish a maximum contaminant level
8 goal and promulgate a national primary drinking water
9 regulation under section 1412 of the Safe Drinking Water

1 Act (42 U.S.C. 300g-1) for chromium-6, which shall in-
2 clude a filtration requirement.
