A BILL

To prohibit public housing agencies from imposing breed restrictions on household pets owned by residents of dwelling units in public housing, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pets Belong With
5 Families Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON BREED RESTRICTIONS.**

7 Section 31 of the United States Housing Act of 1937
8 (42 U.S.C. 1437z–3) is amended by striking subsection
9 (b) and inserting the following:

1 “(b) REASONABLE REQUIREMENTS.—

2 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The reasonable require-
3 ments referred to in subsection (a) may include—

4 “(A) limitations on the number of animals
5 in a unit, based on unit size;

6 “(B) prohibitions on types of animals that
7 are classified as dangerous, provided that classi-
8 fication is based on specific behaviors or actions
9 by the animal and is not based on the breed of
10 the animal; and

11 “(C) restrictions or prohibitions based on
12 size and type of building or project, or other
13 relevant conditions.

14 “(2) LIMITATION.—The reasonable require-
15 ments referred to in subsection (a) may not include
16 prohibitions on breeds of animals.”
