A BILL

To require the Secretary of Agriculture to reissue the final environmental impact statement for the Resolution Copper Project and Land Exchange, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Unleashing American
5 Resources Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR THE**
2 **RESOLUTION COPPER PROJECT AND LAND**
3 **EXCHANGE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
5 date of enactment of this section, the Secretary of Agri-
6 culture shall reissue the final environmental impact state-
7 ment for the Resolution Copper Project and Land Ex-
8 change, which was withdrawn March 5, 2021 (86 Fed.
9 Reg. 12943).

10 (b) LIMITATION.—The Secretary of Agriculture may
11 not withdraw the final environmental impact statement re-
12 issued under subsection (a).

13 (c) COMPLIANCE WITH NEPA.—The final environ-
14 mental impact statement reissued under subsection (a)
15 shall be considered to meet the requirements relating to
16 detailed statements under section 102(2)(C) of the Na-
17 tional Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C.
18 4332(2)(C)) for the Resolution Copper Project and Land
19 Exchange.
