A BILL

To repeal the methane emissions and waste reduction
incentive program for petroleum and natural gas systems.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting the Per-
5 mian Basin Act of 2022”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

2 Section 136 of the Clean Air Act (relating to methane
3 emissions and waste reduction incentive program for pe-
4 troleum and natural gas systems) is repealed.
