3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “State Efforts to Create
5 Underground Regulatory Efficiency Act” or the “SE-
6 CURE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR STATE PERMITTING PRO-**
2 **GRAM GRANTS.**

3 Section 40306(c)(3) of the Infrastructure Investment
4 and Jobs Act (42 U.S.C. 300h–9(c)(3)) is amended by
5 striking “\$50,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2022
6 through 2026” and inserting “\$100,000,000, which shall
7 be authorized to remain available until expended”.

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
