Ms. SCANLON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 4524) to limit the judicial enforceability of predispute nondisclosure and nondisparagement contract clauses relating to disputes involving sexual assault and sexual harassment; and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (S.
3 4524) to limit the judicial enforceability of predispute non-
4 disclosure and nondisparagement contract clauses relating
5 to disputes involving sexual assault and sexual harass-

1 ment. All points of order against consideration of the bill
2 are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points
3 of order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-
4 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
5 and on any amendment thereto to final passage without
6 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
7 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
8 member of the Committee on the Judiciary or their respec-
9 tive designees; and (2) one motion to commit.

10 SEC. 2. (a) At any time through the legislative day
11 of Friday, November 18, 2022, the Speaker may entertain
12 motions offered by the Majority Leader or a designee that
13 the House suspend the rules as though under clause 1 of
14 rule XV with respect to multiple measures described in
15 subsection (b), and the Chair shall put the question on
16 any such motion without debate or intervening motion.

17 (b) A measure referred to in subsection (a) includes
18 any measure that was the object of a motion to suspend
19 the rules on the legislative day of November 14, 2022, No-
20 vember 15, 2022, November 16, 2022, November 17,
21 2022, or November 18, 2022, in the form as so offered,
22 on which the yeas and nays were ordered and further pro-
23 ceedings postponed pursuant to clause 8 of rule XX.

24 (c) Upon the offering of a motion pursuant to sub-
25 section (a) concerning multiple measures, the ordering of

1 the yeas and nays on postponed motions to suspend the
2 rules with respect to such measures is vacated to the end
3 that all such motions are considered as withdrawn.

4 SEC. 3. Notwithstanding clause 8 of rule XX, further
5 proceedings on a vote by the yeas and nays on the question
6 of adoption of a motion that the House suspend the rules
7 offered on the legislative day of November 14, 2022, or
8 November 15, 2022, may be postponed through the legis-
9 lative day of November 18, 2022.

10 SEC. 4. On any legislative day during the period from
11 November 21, 2022, through November 28, 2022, the
12 Journal of the proceedings of the previous day shall be
13 considered as approved.

14 SEC. 5. The Speaker may appoint Members to per-
15 form the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period
16 addressed by section 4 of this resolution as though under
17 clause 8(a) of rule I.

18 SEC. 6. Each day during the period addressed by sec-
19 tion 4 of this resolution shall not constitute a calendar
20 day for purposes of section 7 of the War Powers Resolu-
21 tion (50 U.S.C. 1546).

22 SEC. 7. Each day during the period addressed by sec-
23 tion 4 of this resolution shall not constitute a legislative
24 day for purposes of clause 7 of rule XIII.

1 SEC. 8. Each day during the period addressed by sec-
2 tion 4 of this resolution shall not constitute a calendar
3 or legislative day for purposes of clause 7(c)(1) of rule
4 XXII.

5 SEC. 9. House Resolution 1463 is hereby adopted.
