# RESOLUTION

Impeaching Joseph R. Biden.

1       *Resolved*, That Joseph R. Biden, President of the  
2 United States, is impeached for Treason, and other high  
3 Crimes and Misdemeanors, and that the following articles  
4 of impeachment be exhibited to the United States Senate:

5       Articles of Impeachment exhibited by the House of  
6 Representatives of the United States of America in the  
7 name of itself and of the people of the United States, in  
8 maintenance and support of its impeachment against  
9 President Joseph R. Biden for high crimes and mis-  
10 demeanors.

11       It must be noted that as both Vice President and as  
12 President of the United States, Joseph R. Biden took the

1 following Oath or Affirmation of Office: “I do solemnly  
2 swear (or affirm) that I will faithfully execute the Office  
3 of the President of the United States, and will to the best  
4 of my Ability, preserve, protect and defend the Constitu-  
5 tion of the United States.”

6 ARTICLE I

7 President Joseph R. Biden disastrously managed the  
8 withdrawal of U.S. military, from Afghanistan, and did  
9 intentionally and knowingly leave American citizens and  
10 thousands of our most devoted allies to be murdered, tor-  
11 tured, forced into horrendous and tragic circumstances  
12 though they had been assured the United States would  
13 not abandon them to be murdered by the Taliban, all of  
14 which has provided our enemies with legitimate propa-  
15 ganda that the United States Government cannot be trust-  
16 ed, doing virtually irreparable damage to our Nation’s ef-  
17 fort to defeat enemies of our freedom, while President  
18 Biden, by his actions, did more to give credibility to the  
19 statements by the Chinese Communist Party officials and  
20 Russian diplomats that the United States of America  
21 could not be trusted as an ally, thereby adhering and giv-  
22 ing Aid and Comfort to our enemies at the cost of Amer-  
23 ican lives as well as the lives of those who previously as-  
24 sisted the United States in Afghanistan.

## ARTICLE II

1  
2 President Joseph R. Biden's inhumane and disas-  
3 trous withdrawal from Afghanistan provided a gift of con-  
4 trol over much of Afghanistan to the sworn enemy of the  
5 United States, the Taliban, which had previously been  
6 driven out of Afghanistan by our Afghan allies with the  
7 able assistance of American fighters, weapons, and air  
8 support by early 2002, but President Biden's actions have  
9 now provided an enemy, sworn and dedicated to destroying  
10 the United States, to return to its former reign of terror  
11 across Afghanistan; such action constituting treason in as-  
12 sisting the enemy that inflicted the worst act of war and  
13 murder against Americans on our soil.

14 President Joseph R. Biden had been warned that his  
15 anticipated actions could create the kind of murder, chaos  
16 and damage to American citizens and American allies as  
17 is currently occurring in Afghanistan, yet he moved for-  
18 ward with action that gave aid and comfort to our mur-  
19 derous enemies at the expense of the well-being of the Na-  
20 tion he swore to protect, violating his sworn oath as set  
21 out above; additionally President Biden compounded his  
22 high crime and misdemeanors by making repeated state-  
23 ments to American citizens regarding his retreat from Af-  
24 ghanistan through the media that both he and our enemies

1 knew to be lies regarding the betrayal of our Afghan allies  
2 and surrender to our sworn enemies.

3 ARTICLE III

4 While President Joseph R. Biden continued to assure  
5 the people of the United States that Americans and our  
6 allies were having no trouble getting to the airport in Af-  
7 ghanistan and that the Taliban was letting them through,  
8 people around the world could see at that very time he  
9 was lying and even officials within his own administration  
10 were reporting that President Biden's statements were not  
11 true, all while Americans and our allies were being beaten,  
12 tortured and murdered as President Biden did nothing but  
13 misrepresent the facts, give aid and comfort to our en-  
14 emies, and destroy our Nation's reputation, all while  
15 knowing that in a security alert issued on August 18,  
16 2021, the U.S. Embassy Kabul stated explicitly that  
17 "THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT CANNOT  
18 ENSURE SAFE PASSAGE TO THE HAMID KARZAI  
19 INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT."

20 ARTICLE IV

21 Afghans who would otherwise qualify to leave Af-  
22 ghanistan are now similarly trapped and subject to vio-  
23 lence and death due to President Joseph R. Biden's inten-  
24 tional and knowing withdrawal from Afghanistan in such  
25 a way that the American military that had won every bat-  
26 tle would appear to U.S. enemies as a defeat and sur-

1 render, thus President Joseph R. Biden adhered to our  
2 enemies while giving them aid and comfort, including more  
3 than \$80 billion of military weapons and equipment, along  
4 with at least hundreds of Americans that our enemy could  
5 use to demand and receive vast amounts more of money  
6 to aid the enemy of the U.S. in their next attacks against  
7 us.

8 ARTICLE V

9 President Joseph R. Biden also knew that without  
10 more time for the vetting of potential Afghan immigrants  
11 to the U.S., military and State Department officials may  
12 well be bringing terrorists into the United States that  
13 could add to the Taliban death toll of 9–11, yet he per-  
14 sisted in violating his oath and duty to this country and  
15 our Constitution.

16 The Atlantic’s George Packer quotes then-Vice Presi-  
17 dent Biden as telling a fellow Obama Administration offi-  
18 cial in 2010 that these refugees shouldn’t be a priority  
19 as U.S. troops departed: “F\_\_\_ \_\_ that, we don’t have  
20 to worry about that. We did it in Vietnam, Nixon and Kis-  
21 singer got away with it;” which provides further evidence  
22 that President Biden was and continues to be intentionally  
23 willing to destroy the reputation for trustworthiness of the  
24 United States that had been rebuilt over a period of dec-  
25 ades after the Carter administration, at the cost of thou-  
26 sands of devoted and dedicated military lives and injuries,

1 as those valiant American military members fought evil  
2 and sought to bring peace, now intentionally squandered  
3 by President Joseph R. Biden as he provided aid and com-  
4 fort to all of America's enemies.

5       The doubt President Joseph R. Biden has instilled  
6 across the globe not only does great harm and damage  
7 to the Nation he swore to protect, it does incalculable  
8 harm to the cause of freedom around the world as it has  
9 provided tremendous aid and comfort to the enemies of  
10 the Constitution of the United States and the freedoms  
11 sought to be protected therein.

12                                   ARTICLE VI

13       President Joseph R. Biden set a date for removal of  
14 all American personnel by August 31, 2021, knowing full  
15 well that chaos, murder and mayhem would ensue as indi-  
16 cated by many advisors, yet, he persisted in his orders and  
17 demands knowing that the 20th Anniversary of the worst  
18 attack on American soil killing thousands of Americans  
19 would be less than two weeks thereafter, also knowing that  
20 the most damaging development to this Nation other than  
21 another massive attack would be for the murderous  
22 Taliban members to be able to claim they were victorious  
23 over the United States on that very 20th Anniversary, yet  
24 President Joseph R. Biden persisted in giving aid and  
25 comfort to our enemies while devastating our own Nation's  
26 reputation, even stating that the blame should go to the

1 preceding Administration, whose warnings and safeguards  
2 against such an occurrence had been completely cast aside,  
3 disregarded, and belittled, even though the prior adminis-  
4 tration had provided President Biden a Nation without the  
5 massive insurgence on our southern border, and without  
6 the chaos and betrayal of our Afghan allies.

7 ARTICLE VII

8 On August 20, 2021, President Joseph R. Biden  
9 vowed that “any attack on our forces or disruption of our  
10 operations at the airport will be met with swift and force-  
11 ful response.” However, when the Taliban allowed two ve-  
12 hicle-born IEDs into the airport on August 26, 2021,  
13 which killed thirteen U.S. service members and additional  
14 innocent civilians, President Joseph R. Biden solely  
15 blamed ISIS when he had agreed to allow the Taliban,  
16 an enemy of the U.S., to secure the U.S. perimeter at  
17 Bagram Airfield and allowed ISIS into a position where  
18 they could kill Americans, furthering damage to our rep-  
19 utation while he gave aid and comfort to the Taliban,  
20 China and Russia.

21 ARTICLE VIII

22 President Joseph R. Biden further gave aid and com-  
23 fort to our enemy, the Taliban, by killing civilians friendly  
24 to the U.S. in an ordered drone strike on August 29, 2021,  
25 and then lying to the American people by saying the vic-  
26 tims were ISIS-K “planners.”

## ARTICLE IX

Pursuant to instructions from President Joseph R. Biden, U.S. officials gave the Taliban the names of American citizens, green card holders and Afghan allies who would be allowed into the militant-controlled perimeter of the Kabul airport; such unthinkable action aided U.S. enemies by giving them in effect a “kill list”; and although it was allegedly designed to expedite the evacuation of those fleeing Afghanistan, the truth is that it is “. . . just appalling and shocking and makes you feel unclean”; all of which violated President Joseph R. Biden’s oath to the U.S. and our Constitution while at the same time giving aid in the form of billions of dollars of equipment to our enemies and a list of our allies to either kill, torture or ransom.

## ARTICLE X

More than 20,000 soldiers were wounded in the conflict in Afghanistan, and many of those brave men and women now live with permanent disabilities, and suffer from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder; yet President Joseph R. Biden has chosen to add to their traumatic stress leaving them to wonder if their valorous sacrifices were for nothing, again giving aid and comfort to our enemies while betraying our own military.

In the months since President Joseph R. Biden took control as the loftiest leader in the United States, plots



1 were conceived and created with the blessing of President  
2 Biden to give our enemy and competing nations aid and  
3 comfort; furthermore, President Biden has made decisions  
4 to destroy American credibility on our southern border  
5 and in Afghanistan, despite knowing that from October  
6 2001 through April 2021, more than 2,400 American  
7 service members have been killed in Afghanistan and more  
8 than 3,800 U.S. contractors had also lost their lives.

9 ARTICLE XI

10 Afghan security forces were built and trained at a  
11 two-decade cost of \$83 billion over the course of three  
12 prior administrations, but because of the orders of Presi-  
13 dent Biden, and despite being warned that our enemy, the  
14 Taliban, would probably take over quickly without dif-  
15 ferent presidential orders, President Biden chose the  
16 strategy that would do irreparable harm to the United  
17 States and give aid and comfort to our enemy, causing  
18 the Afghan forces to collapse although a different strategy  
19 would have allowed our allies to remain in control; all as  
20 comments are now being made to slander our allies who  
21 fought ably with us and for us in Afghanistan; however  
22 President Joseph R. Biden continued to insist on a dead-  
23 line and procedure for withdrawal that gave our allied Af-  
24 ghan military no chance to withstand the assault that had  
25 been prepared for such moment and which deadline was  
26 far more helpful to U.S. enemies than our own interests,

1 as our enemy, the Taliban, uses guns, ammunition, ar-  
2 mored personnel carriers, helicopters, massive ammuni-  
3 tion, bombs, and much more that the Biden administra-  
4 tion knowingly has left with our enemy.

5 Between 2003 and 2019, the United States trans-  
6 ferred approximately 75,898 vehicles, 599,690 weapons,  
7 162,643 pieces of communications equipment, 208 air-  
8 craft, and 16,191 pieces of intelligence, surveillance and  
9 reconnaissance equipment to Afghan forces, according to  
10 a 2017 Government Accountability Office report, and also  
11 gave Afghan forces 7,035 machine guns, 4,702 Humvees,  
12 20,040 hand grenades, 2,520 bombs and 1,394 grenade  
13 launchers, along with 211 U.S. supplied aircraft, among  
14 other equipment according to reports from the Special In-  
15 spector General for Afghanistan Reconstruction, which  
16 supplies and equipment were left to the enemy of the U.S.  
17 by direction of President Joseph R. Biden and which aided  
18 and comforted our enemy that murdered thousands in  
19 America on 9–11.

## 20 ARTICLE XII

21 President Joseph R. Biden made the disastrous deci-  
22 sions to abandon both the Bagram Air Base and U.S. Em-  
23 bassy in Kabul which were both paid for at an expensive  
24 cost to the U.S. taxpayer, and provided strategically im-  
25 portant transportation and resources for U.S. citizens and

1 allies stranded in Afghanistan, thereby giving aid and  
2 comfort to enemies of the United States.

3 ARTICLE XIII

4 Article I, Section 8, of the U.S. Constitution requires  
5 that “Congress shall have the power to . . . declare war”  
6 and “to raise and support armies;” and President Biden  
7 acted unlawfully and unconstitutionally in ordering air  
8 strikes in Syria, where there was no clear and present dan-  
9 ger to U.S. troops, which did not aid the United States,  
10 but did commit the crime of intentionally and knowingly  
11 violating his oath to the United States Constitution, and  
12 President Biden previously provided proof of his knowl-  
13 edge that such actions of his own were treasonous by his  
14 claims though unjustified, that President Trump was dan-  
15 gerous “to our national security, to our leadership around  
16 the world and to the lives of the brave women and men  
17 serving in uniform”; establishing his mental capacity to  
18 understand the treasonous course which he himself had  
19 taken.

20 ARTICLE XIV

21 Iran made credible and specific threats against Fort  
22 McNair, a United States Army post in Washington, DC,  
23 and against the Army’s vice chief of staff, Gen. Joseph  
24 M. Martin, and Iran has also continued to enrich its ura-  
25 nium levels toward weapons-grade fissile material to the  
26 detriment of global stability and the national security of

1 the United States and its citizens, while President Biden  
2 has failed to respond to the growing nuclear and terrorist  
3 threats of Iran by continuing to capitulate to their de-  
4 mands, undermining national security, aiding and com-  
5 forting the largest sponsor of terrorism against the United  
6 States and the world, and knowingly putting his own coun-  
7 try in grave peril.

8 ARTICLE XV

9 Though the U.S. Constitution requires that the Presi-  
10 dent “take Care that the Laws be faithfully executed,”  
11 President Joseph R. Biden has blatantly acted not to en-  
12 force our Nation’s duly enacted immigration laws, as dem-  
13 onstrated through overtly opening the U.S. southern bor-  
14 der, failing to keep it as secure as it was when he took  
15 office, all to the treasonous damage to the United States.

16 ARTICLE XVI

17 President Joseph R. Biden and his administration  
18 have been and are transferring people with diseases in-  
19 cluding thousands of immigrants each month suffering  
20 from COVID–19 to undisclosed locations all over our  
21 country just as the Nation had been recovering from such  
22 pandemic, all as President Biden was warning Americans  
23 that they needed to once again give up more of their lib-  
24 erty and freedom because of the new surge in COVID–  
25 19 cases, all clearly demonstrating his willingness to crimi-  
26 nally violate his oath to this country and to this Nation’s

1 Constitution, as Americans continue to become infected  
2 with and die of COVID–19 while the increase in the num-  
3 ber of immigrants illegally flooding into this country from  
4 all over the world continues to set new records, showing  
5 contempt for his sworn oath to the United States and its  
6 Constitution; further, these transfers have happened with-  
7 out the consent of the governed and President Joseph R.  
8 Biden has refused to provide Congress with the data nec-  
9 essary to inform U.S. citizens about the extent and num-  
10 bers of these transfers and how many of those individuals  
11 are Covid positive, though ordering American citizens to  
12 give up their rights to make healthcare decisions over their  
13 own bodies.

14 ARTICLE XVII

15 Article IV, section 4, of the U.S. Constitution re-  
16 quires that “The United States shall guarantee to every  
17 State in this union a republican form of government, and  
18 shall protect each of them against invasion; and on appli-  
19 cation of the legislature, or of the executive (when the leg-  
20 islature cannot be convened) against domestic violence”;  
21 however, President Joseph R. Biden has refused the pleas  
22 of certain border states to reverse course and secure the  
23 southern border against this illegal invasion, even as the  
24 U.S. Border Patrol has continued to report capturing  
25 more terrorists entering our country illegally, and despite  
26 not knowing how many terrorists are entering without

1 being caught, all while President Joseph R. Biden con-  
2 tinues to knowingly violate his oath, aiding our enemies,  
3 sickening, killing, and taking freedoms away from Ameri-  
4 cans.

5 ARTICLE XVIII

6 President Joseph R. Biden intentionally caused  
7 media access to migrant facilities to be restricted during  
8 the ongoing border crisis, promoting an active campaign  
9 of censorship that restricts freedom of the press in direct  
10 violation of the First Amendment of the United States  
11 Constitution that he swore to protect, and President Jo-  
12 seph R. Biden further violated his constitutional responsi-  
13 bility of Congress by even restricting some members of  
14 Congress from being able to do adequate oversight of Fed-  
15 eral border enforcement, while allowing much more free-  
16 dom to those entering unlawfully, to the direct harm of  
17 the United States and to the aid and comfort of our en-  
18 emies and adversaries.

19 ARTICLE XIX

20 President Joseph R. Biden further violated his oath  
21 of office by violating budget rules by freezing billions of  
22 dollars set aside to fund the border wall between the  
23 United States and Mexico, especially considering that  
24 President Joseph R. Biden is taking actions to add further  
25 support for more illegal immigration and take more of the  
26 money authorized only for Americans legally in this coun-

1 try and give it to those who have not only entered illegally,  
2 but some of whom have committed heinous crimes.

3 ARTICLE XX

4 President Joseph R. Biden has signed numerous Ex-  
5 ecutive orders that violate our Nation's Constitution which  
6 have severely restricted the United States ability to be en-  
7 ergy independent, including imposing a moratorium on  
8 new oil and gas leases on Federal lands and waters, em-  
9 bracing disastrously crippling policies that grievously re-  
10 strict our domestic energy production, while also waiving  
11 sanctions that were in place on Russia's vast expansion  
12 of its ability to accelerate its natural gas production, which  
13 it uses to blackmail or extort our allies when it desires,  
14 thus showing that President Biden is violating his oath  
15 of office, aiding and comforting enemies and adversaries,  
16 all while damaging the economy of the United States, and  
17 still further, he is doing great harm to the health and well-  
18 being of Americans struggling to pay the rising energy  
19 costs and inflation that President Biden is creating.

20 ARTICLE XXI

21 In furtherance of his intentions to harm American  
22 interests and help our enemies, President Joseph R. Biden  
23 violated his oath to the U.S. Constitution and usurped au-  
24 thority he did not have by revoking the Keystone XL Pipe-  
25 line, as that power to regulate foreign and interstate com-  
26 merce belongs solely to Congress, yet he violated his con-

stitutional oath and authority to the intentional detriment of the American people and for the aid and comfort to Russia and its oligarchs as well as the Chinese Communist Party, which have both provided large amounts of payments to President Joseph R. Biden's family.

ARTICLE XXII

President Joseph R. Biden suspended for 90 days and then subsequently revoked President Trump's Executive Order 13920, and thereby ended the prohibition of China, Russia, and other foreign adversaries, from accessing or owning parts of the U.S. power grid, which gave massive aid and comfort to American adversaries while doing incalculable damage to the security of the United States and left the working people and those on fixed incomes extremely vulnerable to foreign interference with their freedom and ability to live without suffering, thereby showing more deference and regard for America's adversaries than for his own American people.

ARTICLE XXIII

President Joseph R. Biden further put Americans in harm's way by revoking President Donald J. Trump's Executive Order 13942 that addressed the threat that TikTok posed to Americans and which order was issued to ensure that Americans' personal data would be free from Chinese manipulation and influence, yet President Joseph R. Biden intentionally and knowingly put the very



1 people he took an oath to protect in clear and present dan-  
 2 ger and gave aid and comfort to U.S. adversaries.

3 ARTICLE XXIV

4 President Joseph R. Biden has officially kept in place  
 5 the important restrictions that President Trump imposed  
 6 on the Chinese telecommunications firm, Huawei, to re-  
 7 strict the sale of microchips to Huawei, yet the Biden ad-  
 8 ministration has in fact approved licenses for Huawei to  
 9 buy microchips from U.S.-based suppliers for use in parts  
 10 including video screens, sensors and its auto component  
 11 business, all of which has aided our enemy while jeopard-  
 12 izing America's national security.

13 ARTICLE XXV

14 President Joseph R. Biden has taken broad actions  
 15 to infringe on the constitutional rights that he swore to  
 16 protect and defend, and in particular, the Second Amend-  
 17 ment of the Constitution by creating Executive orders that  
 18 not only do not defend the Constitution as he swore, but  
 19 show an intent to violate the Constitution and the rights  
 20 it recognizes that belong to the American people, as Presi-  
 21 dent Biden unconstitutionally legislated gun control re-  
 22 strictions by his orders.

23 ARTICLE XXVI

24 Our Constitution exists to constrain tyrannical power  
 25 and establish a system of governance in the interest of  
 26 the People, thereby securing their lives and the Blessings

1 of Liberty, yet President Joseph R. Biden continued to  
2 unlawfully deprive U.S. citizens of their lawful occupa-  
3 tions, by directing the Centers for Disease Control and  
4 Prevention (CDC) to extend the eviction moratorium in  
5 August 2021, although the U.S. Supreme Court had held  
6 in June 2021 that any further extension beyond July 2021  
7 would need to be congressionally approved, and which ac-  
8 tion by President Joseph R. Biden was so unconstitu-  
9 tional, that it could not pass a Democrat-led House of  
10 Representatives or Senate. By supporting this action,  
11 President Biden acted to intentionally usurp the rule of  
12 law in order to deprive our Nation's landlords of the in-  
13 comes they rely on to pay their own mortgages on such  
14 buildings, to feed their families and to provide for their  
15 own shelter, although he had previously acknowledged that  
16 such action was likely unconstitutional, all in knowingly  
17 violating his oath of office and intentionally harming  
18 America while aiding its adversaries.

19 ARTICLE XXVII

20 Joseph R. Biden, while Vice President of the United  
21 States, corruptly used his office and position of trust to  
22 enrich himself and family members, directly violating his  
23 oath of office by engaging in bribery as both a recipient  
24 and as the provider of a bribe, treasonously harming his  
25 country in order to receive money, and in order to shield  
26 his son from prosecution. Not only did he use his position

1 of trust to gain financial rewards for himself and his fam-  
2 ily, he engaged in foreign business entanglements that  
3 were a direct conflict of interest, a direct violation of his  
4 oath of office, and were exacerbated by his denials of any  
5 knowledge of his family members' foreign business deal-  
6 ings, while knowing full well of those precise self-dealings,  
7 all while demonstrating his knowledge of his high crimes  
8 and misdemeanors by lying repeatedly about his involve-  
9 ment and complicity because he knew it could subject him  
10 to impeachment and potential criminal liability as it did  
11 for Vice President Spiro Agnew. Such criminal mens rea  
12 was also demonstrated when, as Vice President, Joseph  
13 R. Biden met with his son's Chinese business partner,  
14 helping Hunter Biden secure a billion-dollar private equity  
15 account. Further evidencing Vice President Biden's in-  
16 volvement in the pay-to-play scheme that would enrich  
17 Hunter Biden who would provide part of his criminal re-  
18 wards back to his father, Vice President Joseph R. Biden,  
19 all demonstrated by evidence on Hunter Biden's hard  
20 drive including the revelation that in 2015 Joe Biden met  
21 with a high-level official of the Ukrainian energy company,  
22 Burisma, which had put Hunter on its board. Further,  
23 in 2018 Joseph R. Biden bragged on video to the Council  
24 on Foreign Relations that he had a Ukrainian prosecutor  
25 fired when he was vice president in return for making

1 money available to Ukraine that Congress had appro-  
2 priated, though Congress did not intend it to be used to  
3 shield Vice President Biden's son from Ukrainian prosecu-  
4 tion.

5 CONCLUSION

6 In all of the aforementioned, President Joseph R.  
7 Biden by his actions and intentional omissions, despite the  
8 profound duties of our Nation's highest office and the  
9 dignities and proprieties thereof, and of the harmony, re-  
10 spect, and courtesies necessary for stability within the so-  
11 ciety of the United States, has undermined the integrity  
12 of his office, has sown discord among the people of the  
13 United States, has brought disrepute, contempt, ridicule  
14 and disgrace on the Presidency, has abandoned our only  
15 friends and allies in Afghanistan while assisting the ascent  
16 of our Nation's declared enemies, has acted in a manner  
17 antithetical to the cause of a just society, has betrayed  
18 trust as President to the manifest injury of the people of  
19 the United States, and committed in the aforementioned  
20 violations, treason, bribery, as well as high crimes and  
21 misdemeanors in office.

22 Therefore, President Joseph R. Biden, by committing  
23 treason, bribery, high crimes and misdemeanors, the viola-  
24 tion of any of which constitutionally establish that he is

- 1 unfit to be President, has, therefore, made necessary his
- 2 own impeachment, trial, and removal from office.
