## A BILL

To include Portugal in the list of foreign states whose nationals are eligible for admission into the United States as E–1 and E–2 nonimmigrants if United States nationals are treated similarly by the Government of Portugal and to otherwise modify the eligibility criteria for E visas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLES.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Advancing Mutual In-  
5 terests and Growing Our Success Act” or the “AMIGOS  
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NONIMMIGRANT TRADERS AND INVESTORS.**

2 For purposes of clauses (i) and (ii) of section  
3 101(a)(15)(E) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8  
4 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)(E)), Portugal shall be considered to  
5 be a foreign state described in such section if the Govern-  
6 ment of Portugal provides similar nonimmigrant status to  
7 nationals of the United States.

8 **SEC. 3. MODIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR E**  
9 **VISAS.**

10 Section 101(a)(15)(E) of the Immigration and Na-  
11 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)(E)) is amended—

12 (1) in the matter preceding clause (i)—

13 (A) by inserting “(or, in the case of an  
14 alien who acquired the relevant nationality  
15 through a financial investment and who has not  
16 previously been granted status under this sub-  
17 paragraph, the foreign state of which the alien  
18 is a national and in which the alien has been  
19 domiciled for a continuous period of not less  
20 than 3 years at any point before applying for  
21 a nonimmigrant visa under this subparagraph)”  
22 before “, and the spouse”; and

23 (B) by striking “him” and inserting “such  
24 alien”; and

- 1 (2) by striking “he” each place such term ap-
- 2 pears and inserting “the alien”.
