A BILL

To provide for the implementation of certain trafficking in contracting provisions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End Human Traf-
5 ficking in Government Contracts Act of 2022”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAFFICKING IN CON-**
2 **TRACTING PROVISIONS.**

3 (a) REQUIREMENT TO REFER VIOLATIONS TO AGEN-
4 CY SUSPENSION AND DEBARMENT OFFICIAL.—Section
5 1704(c)(1) of the National Defense Authorization Act for
6 Fiscal Year 2013 (Public Law 112–239; 22 U.S.C.
7 7104b(c)(1)) is amended—

8 (1) by inserting “refer the matter to the agency
9 suspension and debarment official and” before “con-
10 sider taking one of the following actions”; and

11 (2) by striking subparagraph (G).

12 (b) REPORT ON IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAFFICKING
13 IN CONTRACTING PROVISIONS.—Not later than 90 days
14 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director
15 of the Office of Management and Budget shall submit to
16 Congress a report on implementation of title XVII of the
17 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2013
18 (Public Law 112–239; 126 Stat. 2092).

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
