1 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF RESTRICTION ON VETERANS**
2 **CONCURRENTLY SERVING IN THE OFFICES**
3 **OF ADMINISTRATOR AND DEPUTY ADMINIS-**
4 **TRATOR OF THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMIN-**
5 **ISTRATION.**

6 Section 106(d)(1) of title 49, United States Code, is
7 amended by striking “, a retired regular officer of an
8 armed force, or a former regular officer of an armed
9 force”.

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
