A BILL

To allow Federal law enforcement officers to purchase retired
service weapons, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Law Enforce-
5 ment Service Weapon Purchase Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PURCHASE OF RETIRED HANDGUNS BY FEDERAL**
7 **LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.**

8 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1 (1) the term “Federal law enforcement officer”
2 has the meaning given that term in section
3 115(c)(1) of title 18, United States Code;

4 (2) the term “handgun” has the meaning given
5 that term in section 921(a) of title 18, United
6 States Code; and

7 (3) the term “retired handgun” means any
8 handgun that has been declared surplus by the ap-
9 plicable agency.

10 (b) AUTHORIZATION.—A Federal law enforcement of-
11 ficer may purchase a retired handgun from the Federal
12 agency that issued the handgun to such officer.

13 (c) LIMITATIONS.—A Federal law enforcement officer
14 may purchase a retired handgun under subsection (b) if—

15 (1) the purchase is made during the 6-month
16 period beginning on the date the handgun was so re-
17 tired; and

18 (2) the officer is not prohibited from possessing
19 or receiving the handgun under the laws of the
20 United States or the laws of the State, territory, or
21 possession of the United States in which the officer
22 resides.

23 (d) COST.—A handgun purchased under this section
24 shall be sold at the fair market value for such handgun
25 taking into account the age and condition of the handgun.

1 (e) POLICY GUIDANCE.—The Administrator of Gen-
2 eral Services shall develop policies to facilitate the sale and
3 disposition of eligible handguns under this section con-
4 sistent with section 922 of title 18, United States Code.
