Ms. COLLINS (for herself, Mr. WARNER, Mrs. CAPITO, Mr. MARKEY, Mr. MORAN, and Mr. MENENDEZ) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To extend the National Alzheimer’s Project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NAPA Reauthorization
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROJECT.**

7 Section 2 of the National Alzheimer’s Project Act (42
8 U.S.C. 11225) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (c)—

1 (A) in paragraph (2), by striking “and co-
 2 ordination of” and inserting “on, and coordina-
 3 tion of,”;

4 (B) in paragraph (4)—

5 (i) by redesignating subparagraphs
 6 (A) and (B) as subparagraphs (B) and
 7 (C), respectively; and

8 (ii) by inserting before subparagraph
 9 (B), as so redesignated, the following:

10 “(A) promotion of healthy aging and re-
 11 duction of risk factors for Alzheimer’s dis-
 12 ease;”;

13 (C) in paragraph (5), by striking “; and”
 14 and inserting a semicolon;

15 (D) by redesignating paragraph (6) as
 16 paragraph (7); and

17 (E) by inserting after paragraph (5) the
 18 following:

19 “(6) provide information on, and promote the
 20 adoption of, healthy behaviors that may reduce the
 21 risk of cognitive decline and promote and protect
 22 cognitive health; and”;

23 (2) in subsection (d)(2)—

24 (A) by inserting “, across public and pri-
 25 vate sectors,” after “Nation’s progress”; and

(B) by inserting “, including consideration of public-private collaborations, as appropriate” before the period;

(3) in subsection (e)—

(A) in paragraph (2)—

(i) in subparagraph (A), by adding at the end the following:

“(xi) A designee of the Department of Justice.

“(xii) A designee of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

“(xiii) A designee of the Social Security Administration.

“(xiv) A designee of the Office of Management and Budget.”; and

(ii) in subparagraph (B)—

(I) in clause (v)—

(aa) by striking “2 researchers” and inserting “3 researchers”; and

(bb) by striking “; and” and inserting “, including at least one researcher with demonstrated experience in recruitment and re-

1 tention of diverse cohorts of trial
2 participants;”;

3 (II) in clause (vi), by striking the
4 period and inserting “; and”; and

5 (III) by adding at the end the
6 following:

7 “(vii) an individual with a diagnosis of
8 Alzheimer’s disease.”;

9 (B) in paragraph (5)—

10 (i) in subparagraph (A)—

11 (I) by striking “an initial evalua-
12 tion” and inserting “annual evalua-
13 tions”; and

14 (II) by striking “research, clin-
15 ical” and inserting “research, risk re-
16 duction, public health, clinical”;

17 (ii) in subparagraph (B), by striking
18 “initial”;

19 (iii) in subparagraph (C)—

20 (I) in the matter preceding clause
21 (i), by striking “initial”; and

22 (II) in clause (ii), by inserting
23 “and reduce disparities” before the
24 semicolon; and

1 (iv) in subparagraph (D), by striking
2 “annually thereafter, an evaluation” and
3 inserting “annual evaluations”; and
4 (C) in paragraph (6), by striking “2025”
5 and inserting “2035”;
6 (4) in subsection (g)(3)(A)(ii), by inserting
7 “and reduce disparities” before the semicolon; and
8 (5) in subsection (h), by striking “2025” and
9 inserting “2035”.

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
